| Less than 2 weeks prior to the <br> course starting date | No | No refund possible <br> However, we offer alternatives: <br> - Option 1: can defer the full payment to <br> the next intake <br> - Option 2: can invite a colleague/friend <br> to apply for the same course, same <br> intake. If admitted, this colleague/friend <br> can participate in the course using this <br> payment. This option is only available for <br> applicants who don't require an entry <br> Visa. |
| After the course has started | No | No refund \& No payment deferral <br> possible |
